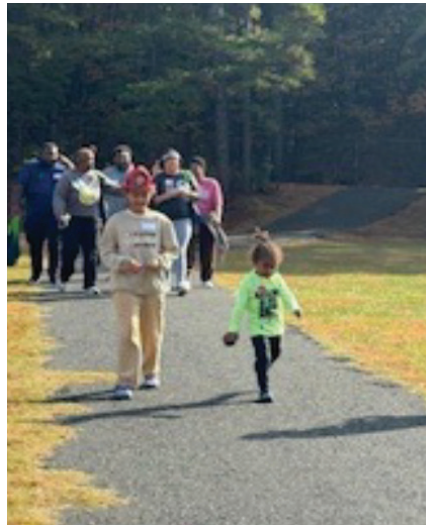

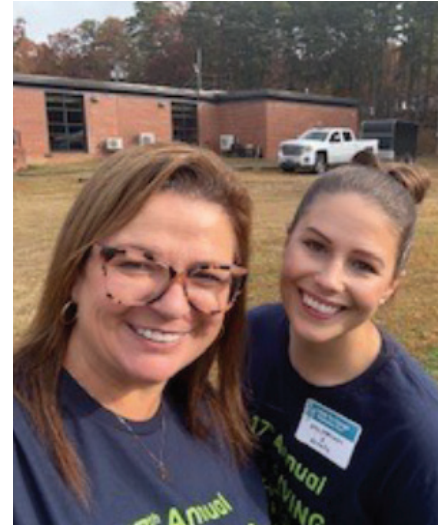
Atrium Health Stanly and Stanly Health Foundation Partner for 17th Annual Diabetes Walk & Health Fair

Over 170 people attended the 17th Annual Diabetes Walk on November 8, which was held at the EE Waddell Center in Albemarle, for a day of fitness, fun and learning about healthy living. The event was co-sponsored by Stanly Health Foundation and Atrium Health Stanly. The goal of the Annual Diabetes Walk & Health Fair is to bring awareness and support to people in our community who are managing diabetes and working to live healthier lives every day. In NC, more than 50,000 people are diagnosed with diabetes each year.

Participants at the event had the opportunity to take a 20-minute chair exercise session and walk laps around the walking track with family and friends to the upbeat tunes of DJ Joey Gathings. Pre-registered participants also received a free t-shirt designed especially for the event and earned tickets by participating in exercise sessions for door prizes like a meal prep kit, crockpot, air fryer, home exercise equipment, and a \$100 shopping spree with Daniel Harkey to learn about healthy food choices. There were 21 different vendors at the event offering participants valuable resources and information on diabetes management.

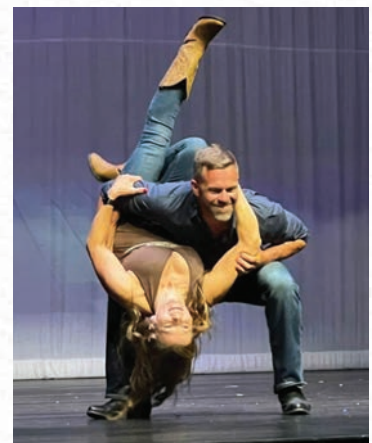

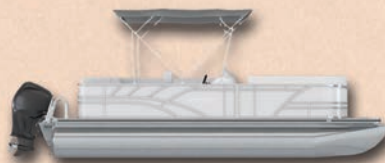
